

## Conversation Starters

- When someone asks about some of the things Jesus did, what comes to your mind first?
- How did the way you grew up impact what you already knew about what Jesus did?

## Discuss

Jesus did many things during his lifetime, some of which may be confusing to us. One of the more intriguing questions revolves around the relationship between God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit – known as the Trinity. Jesus the Son praying to God the Father was a reflection of community, which is inherently part of his nature.

- How does this enhance your understanding of God and Jesus’ life?
- How can you relate to this through your own personal relationships?
- How does this affect your prayer life?

Some of the things Jesus did were a reflection of his love for the least and the lost. Christians learn to grow in that love and share that heartbeat that Jesus had for the least and the lost in our community.

- What are some of the things or causes or people that you have a deep passion for?
- What would you do to protect or stand up for them?
- How can you share that same passion for the least and lost?

Jesus knew his mission and purpose during his time here on earth, and never lost sight of that. He engaged with the devil when he started his ministry and also chose Judas knowing Judas would betray him, but did it in light of the big picture and how his life would end.

- What struck you about Jesus’ focus?
- How has his focus inspired you?
