Finding Your Way to You: The Bible, The Enneagram, and Self-Understanding

Conversation Starters

- If you went into a job interview and were asked about your strengths, what would you say?
- What about your weaknesses?

Discuss

When it comes to the Christian life, there is a self to lose, and a self to find. Read this:

...throw off your old sinful nature and your former way of life, which is corrupted by lust and deception. Instead, let the Spirit renew your thoughts and attitudes. Put on your new nature, created to be like God—truly righteous and holy. (Ephesians 4:22-24)

But now is the time to get rid of anger, rage, malicious behavior, slander, and dirty language. Don't lie to each other, for you have stripped off your old sinful nature and all its wicked deeds. Put on your new nature, and be renewed as you learn to know your Creator and become like him. (Colossians 3:8-10)

Before you can put on your new self, you have to take off your old self. But if you do not have self-understanding, this can prove to be pretty difficult or not as effective of a process.

- Do you know the areas in your life that you tend to struggle?
- Do you know who you are striving to be and what attitudes you should be working to put on?

There are many different ways and tests that are available to help you understand what your strengths are. It's always a good practice to ask close friends and family and mentors. The Enneagram, used correctly, is a great resource with Christian roots:



- Can you identify anyone in your life that knows you well enough to know your strengths and weaknesses?
- According to the Enneagram, what "type(s)" are you? (See "Resources" below.)
- Do you find this to be pretty accurate?
- How does this help you understand how you can grow spiritually?
