

• POPCORN •

Take turns with family members saying the verse but stop midverse and yell "POPCORN" to call on someone else to finish.

• ON THE SPOT •

Challenge any family member to say the verse on the spot! If they recite it perfectly, show them some love by doing one of their chores for them.

MIRROR IMAGE

Use a dry erase marker or window crayon and write or draw the memory verse on the bathroom mirror. Get creative!

• THE NEXT WORD •

Take turns with family members saying the next word of the verse until you complete the whole verse.

• LIVE IT OUT •

Pick one part of the verse where it says what love is and find a way to do that! Example: for "love is kind" do something for someone in your home without being asked.

• PICTURE THIS •

Act or draw out one part of the verse and see if the other person (or team) can guess what it is. This challenge is like playing Charades or Pictionary.

A CHALLENGE

Look up the famous "love chapter" (1 Corinthians 13) from the Bible and read it! This month you are going to **memorize verses** 4-7. Sound hard? Start simple. Read it with your family then do the challenges shown to the left (preschoolers can use the placemat found on the next page).
